# 4. SPIRIT OF PRIDE

An excessive love for oneself, or an exaggerated view of one's own importance or abilities. Pride is taking the glory that belongs to God alone and keeping it for ourselves. Pride is essentially self-worship. (Proverbs 16:18)

Scriptures: Proverbs 8:13; James 4:6-7; Philippians 2:3; Psalm 10:4

## **ACTION STEP**

You must do it God's way and not yours. Ask God to show you what to do next in your life and be willing to do whatever He directs you to do.

#### Note:

When in doubt about a path you believe is from God, seek His confirmation in the Bible, for any true guidance will always align with His Word.

# 5. NOT KNOWING WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS

It is extremely difficult to be obedient to what the Bible says without knowing what it says. As believers, we must take the appropriate and necessary steps to learn as much about God and His Word as possible if we expect to be blessed. (2 Timothy 2:15)

Scriptures: Hosea 4:6; Romans 10:17; Hebrews 10:23-24; Matt. 22:29

#### **ACTION STEP**

Read God's Word Daily! You can obtain a devotional book, meditate on the scripture of the day, listen to scripture readings in the car or write down scriptures that relate to an area of need in your life. You need to know what God's Word says in order to have faith for it. We access the promises (blessings) of God through faith.

#### 6. NOT DOING WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS

To know what God says to do and not do it is akin to spiritual suicide. In other words, you basically kill yourself spiritually, as well as your blessings. (James 4:17)

**Scriptures:** James 1:22; 1 John 1:6; 1 John 2:15-17

### **ACTION STEP**

As you read the Bible daily, always assess your life to see if it is in line with scripture. If it is not, ask God to help you through the power of the Holy Spirit to make the necessary changes in your life to do what the Bible says to do!
