4. Jehovah - Jireh

God is Jehovah - Jireh - The Lord will Provide (Genesis 22:9-14)

The drama and significance of the event in Abraham's life was to prove his faithfulness to God and God's faithfulness to Abraham. God wanted to see if Abraham would trust Him with the promise He had fulfilled for him in giving him a son in his old age. Abraham passed the test and the ram God provided proved that He is Jehovah–Jireh.

God wants us to know as well that He is t he God that can and will provide for all our needs. God is just waiting for his children to increase their faith and trust levels in Him and His Word! (Philippians 4:19, Psalms 34:10, Jeremiah 17:7-8)

5. Jehovah-Shalom

God is Jehovah-Shalom—The Lord is our Peace (Judges 6:22-24)

My brothers and sisters, there is a peace that only God can give. It is a peace that the world cannot understand. During all of our tests and trials, the peace of God that passes all understanding will overwhelm us and bring us to that place of peace and great comfort. Only a serious Christ-follower can truly understand the mystery of the workings of the Holy Spirit in this way.
