How to Eliminate Blessing Blockers

GET IN POSITION TO RECEIVE YOUR MIRACLE/BREAKTHROUGH

PART 3



Many Christians are asking God to move in their lives in one form or another and have not received an answer. It is possible that they haven't heard from God yet due to unseen Blessing Blockers. In this series, we will identify these blessing blockers, outline scriptures for overcoming them, and provide actionable steps to help unlock your blessings. Let's dive in!

7. NOT FOLLOWING BIBLICAL INSTRUCTIONS ON GIVING

Not following Biblical Instructions on giving is one of the major blessing blockers of believers. There are two major issues with believers in this area:

- 1. They believe they are the owners of the resources in their pockets and
- 2. They don't trust God enough to truly lay out on Him and tithe. (Luke 6:38)

Scriptures: Malachi 3:10; Matthew 6:1-4; 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

ACTION STEP

Pray and fast in this area of your life. Then ask God where and when to give and follow through. Pray over your gift and stand on God's Word that it would be multiplied back to you.



8. LACK OF PATIENCE

This is another area where believers in Christ fall short and get their blessings blocked! We ask God for things but will not keep the faith to receive it. We also ask God for things but will not exercise the patience needed to receive it. (Hebrews 6:12)

Scriptures: James 5:7-8; James 1:2-4; Galatians 6:9

ACTION STEP

Through prayer, ask God to strengthen you while you patiently wait for Him to answer. Then recite the promises of God from the scripture, knowing that the passage of time does not negate His Word!

9. UNFORGIVENESS OR HOLDING ON TO THE PAST

The bible clearly states that if we don't forgive those who sin and trespass against us, He will not forgive our sins and trespasses as well. Many people can't get where they desire to be because they won't let go of the past! They won't forgive what happened 5, 10, 15, 20 years ago and wonder why they can't get a breakthrough. Your blessings are being blocked because you won't forgive. You keep holding on to what is not beneficial to you. (Hebrews 12:15)

Scriptures: Matthew 6: 12-15; Ephesians 4:31-32; Colossians 3:13

ACTION STEP

Forgive those who have hurt you and let it go! Look to God for a better future. If you are struggling to forgive, look at Philippians 4:13 for biblical help in this area.
